Once again we have a reduced number of teams entered in this year's competition. This has required another new draw to be developed. This draw is generated by code, not club teams. Individual teams are later allocated against each code, according to the random ballot at the April zone meeting, which determines gear check order. Therefore it is not possible to predict or nominate in advance, which teams will ride against each other in any heat of each game. Although some teams will ride against each other 3 or 4 times and against another team, only once or twice, it will be entirely random. Without a perfect draw of 25 teams, this is unavoidable!

This year we will run 3 heats of each game and use 4 lanes. The draw gives 4 teams a 130 point minimum score and seven teams a 140 point minimum score, so is relatively even. This should not be a problem when we are scoring maximum points.

NMZ GAMES & FLAT TEAMS DAY – GEAR CHECK TIMES

Clubs must check the PCAV web site for information relating to Games & Flat Teams competition – particularly in regard to armbands for riders and team managers. Clubs are responsible for supplying their own back numbers for flat /musical ride teams (nos 1 – 4) and armbands with the team letter in the appropriate colour for age for all games team members.

Cards to be handed to the event secretary in teams by the DC or team manager.

Individual rider's cards will not be accepted. Please ensure that the cards are properly completed, including DC & secretary's signature, riders name, club, and date of birth, transfer or new member date if less than twelve months and correct name of horse/pony (i.e. name of horse on entry and card should be the same.) The card check at the games is important, as they must be verified for the state event
